

24 Homefayre House, Fareham — retiree area guide

Tucked just off *Western Road*, moments from West Street, 24 Homefayre House sits in a calm, level pocket of central Fareham: everyday shops within a short stroll, buses at the town's bus station, and gentle green spaces for an easy daily loop. This guide focuses on what life feels like here for a retired resident—especially if step-free routes, quiet convenience, and easy routines matter.

At a glance

- Flat, walkable town-centre setting just off West Street for cafés, everyday shops and places to pause; Fareham Shopping Centre is a few minutes on foot.
- Frequent local buses from Fareham Bus Station (including Eclipse E1/E2) and *step-free* national rail at Fareham Station (lifts to all platforms).
- Westbury Manor *Garden* in town for a quiet sit; easy outings to Portchester Castle, Hill Head promenade and Titchfield Haven's boardwalks.
- Pharmacies and GP surgeries close by; nearest A&E at Queen Alexandra Hospital (Cosham) with clinics at Fareham Community Hospital (Sarisbury Green).
- Friendly community spaces—Fareham Library and the new Fareham Live theatre—offering welcoming, accessible facilities.

The neighbourhood vibe

Step outside and you're in central Fareham: broad pavements, dropped kerbs and a gentle, small-town rhythm. West Street provides the everyday—coffee, a paper, groceries—without the need for a big trip, while the Shopping Centre keeps most errands under one roof. When you fancy some quiet, the little period *garden* behind Westbury Manor offers benches and planting for a short wander and a sit.

Everyday essentials

- *Groceries & bits:* West Street shops and Fareham Shopping Centre for daily needs; a larger Tesco Superstore sits nearby for a bigger shop.
- *Pharmacies & health:* Boots (Westbury Mall) and Superdrug Pharmacy (Thackeray Square) serve prescriptions and over-the-counter needs. Nearby GP options include Fareham Centre Practice (Civic Way). For urgent care, Queen Alexandra Hospital provides A&E; clinics and outpatient services run from Fareham Community Hospital.
- *Post & banking:* Post Office counters and cashpoints are dotted along the West Street/Portchester corridor for quick errands.

Getting around (easy options, little effort)

- *On foot or with a mobility aid:* Largely level pavements with plentiful benches around town; Shopmobility at the Shopping Centre hires scooters and wheelchairs for simple, independent trips.
- *By train:* Fareham Station is *Category A step-free* with lifts to all platforms and staff assistance available.
- *By bus:* Regular services from the Bus Station, including Eclipse E1/E2 on the Gosport–Fareham busway for smooth, reliable journeys. First Bus operates low-floor accessible vehicles.
- *By car or taxi:* Blue Badge holders benefit from concessions and signed disabled bays in town-centre car parks; check council guidance before you go.

Green spaces

- *Westbury Manor Garden:* A small, level period garden right in town—ideal for “walk—sit—walk” loops with planting interest and benches.
- *Portchester Castle (grounds):* Broad, mostly level routes within the outer bailey and ramped access to ground-floor exhibits; a gentle heritage stroll with harbour views.
- *Hill Head promenade:* Long, level seafront for easy, breezy walks with regular seating; recent works have reopened the promenade.
- *Titchfield Haven NNR:* Boardwalk paths to hides make for simple, nature-rich outings (check for any access updates before visiting).

- *Fareham Library*: Lift access, accessible toilets and assistive tech—handy for quiet reading, printing and local info.
- *Fareham Live (theatre)*: Step-free throughout, with companion ticket policy and accessible parking nearby.
- *Cafés & everyday stops*: Independent spots and familiar names line West Street, with places to pause before or after errands at the Shopping Centre.

Accessibility notes for disabled retirees

- *Step-free lifestyle*: Town-centre pavements are generally level, with benches and resting spots; Shopmobility hires scooters and wheelchairs from inside the Shopping Centre.
- *Transport accessibility*: Fareham Station is step-free (lifts), and First buses are designed for easy access with wheelchair space.
- *Blue Badge & parking*: Council car parks provide disabled bays and concessions—useful for quick errands or theatre visits.

A gentle day from your front door

Begin with a coffee on West Street, then take a flat amble to Westbury Manor Garden for a quiet sit among the borders. After lunch, hop on a frequent bus or the short train for a relaxed explore of Portchester Castle's waterside grounds, before picking up groceries on the way home and putting the kettle on as the afternoon light softens.

Who this location suits

- Retirees who value walkable, level access to daily amenities
- Anyone who enjoys green spaces and gentle heritage outings nearby
- Those who like quiet convenience with transport and services within easy reach

Approximate distances (on foot)

- West Street shops & cafés: ~2–4 minutes

- Fareham Station: ~12–15 minutes (*step-free*)
- Library / pharmacy: ~6–10 minutes
