

## 41 Homestour House, Christchurch — *retiree area guide*

Tucked on Barrack Road, moments from Christchurch's compact town centre and the Priory, 41 Homestour House places you in a calm, level pocket with everyday shops a short stroll away, frequent buses close by, and riverside greens for gentle loops. This guide focuses on what life feels like here for a retired resident—especially if step-free routes, quiet convenience, and easy routines matter.

### At a glance

- Flat, walkable setting on Barrack Road for cafés, everyday shops and places to pause; town-centre groceries at Waitrose (Fountain Roundabout), M&S Simply Food on the High Street, and Iceland in Saxon Square.
- Frequent local buses from Barrack Road/Bargates: Morebus X1/X2 (Bournemouth—Christchurch—Lymington) plus local routes including 1B/1C and 33.
- Easy green options: Christchurch Quay & Priory Gardens for level riverside paths; Stanpit Marsh for wide, mostly flat tracks and benches; relaxed accessible outings to Hengistbury Head (land train with wheelchair carriage).
- GP surgeries and pharmacies nearby (Stour Surgery on Barrack Road; Boots in Twynham Avenue/Saxon Square). Main hospitals at Christchurch Hospital (outpatients/day services) and Royal Bournemouth Hospital (A&E).
- Community spaces in the centre—Christchurch Library, the Regent Centre (theatre/cinema), and Red House Museum & Gardens—with welcoming, accessible facilities.

### The neighbourhood vibe

Step outside and you're on straight, town-centre streets with broad pavements and dropped kerbs. Saxon Square and the High Street give you the practical bits—groceries, the post office, a coffee and a seat—without planning a big trip. The riverside at the Quay adds that “five-minutes-to-green” feel, with boats, lawns and benches shaping an easy daily rhythm.

## Everyday essentials

- **Groceries & bits:** Waitrose (Fountain Roundabout), M&S Simply Food (High Street) and Iceland (Saxon Square) cover the dailies; there's also a Tesco Express along Barrack Road for quick top-ups.
- **Pharmacies & health:** Boots Pharmacy at Twynham Avenue and in Saxon Square. GP care at Stour Surgery, 49 Barrack Road. A&E at Royal Bournemouth Hospital; outpatient/day services at Christchurch Hospital.
- **Post & banking:** Christchurch Post Office in Saxon Square; cashpoints around the centre and supermarkets.

## Getting around (easy options, little effort)

- **On foot or with a mobility aid:** Town-centre pavements are generally level with dropped kerbs; Priory/Quay paths are mostly flat and dotted with seating.
- **By bus:** From Barrack Road/Bargates, Morebus X1/X2 link Christchurch with Royal Bournemouth Hospital, Bournemouth and Lymington; other local routes (1B/1C/33) fill nearby links. Low-floor, ramp-equipped buses simplify boarding.
- **By train:** Christchurch station (Stour Road) has step-free access to each platform via separate entrances; the step-free route between platforms is via the street. Assistance and ramps available.
- **By car or taxi:** Saxon Square has on-site parking; Christchurch Quay and Priory car parks include disabled bays for shorter stroll-and-sit visits.

## Green spaces

- **Christchurch Quay & Priory Gardens:** Level riverside strolling and places to sit within a short walk of the High Street.
- **Druitt Gardens:** A quiet green behind the library for short, shady loops between errands.
- **Stanpit Marsh Nature Reserve:** Broad, mostly flat paths (can be wet with tides), raised sleeper bridges and some seating for rests.
- **Hengistbury Head & Mudeford Spit:** Waymarked paths; accessible land train with a wheelchair carriage for a relaxed outing and big harbour views.

## Culture, coffee & community

- **Christchurch Library:** Central, accessible library with regular activities and gentle tech help.
- **Regent Centre (theatre/cinema):** Films, talks and shows; accessible seating available via the box office.
- **Red House Museum & Gardens:** Ground-floor and garden areas are wheelchair-friendly; café on site.
- **Everyday stops:** M&S/Waitrose/Iceland for bits; cafés cluster around the High Street and Saxon Square.

## Accessibility notes for disabled retirees

- **Step-free lifestyle:** Streets around Barrack Road and the central routes to the Priory/Quay are largely level; town-centre venues (library, Regent Centre, museum) provide accessible toilets and seating.
- **Transport accessibility:** Morebus operates low-floor, ramp-equipped vehicles and accepts wheelchairs/mobility scooters within stated dimensions; drivers can deploy the ramp on request.
- **Rail alternatives:** Christchurch station offers step-free access to each platform via street routes; staff can provide ramps/assistance.
- **Mobility support:** Nearby suppliers for scooters/wheelchairs include Ableworld (Christchurch) and Mobility Station (sales/servicing).

## A gentle day from your front door

Start with a quiet amble into Saxon Square—pick up a paper, post a parcel, then linger over a coffee. Late morning, take the X1/X2 from Barrack Road to the Quay and wander the river path, or ride out to Hengistbury Head and hop on the land train for harbour views without the effort. On the way back, drop into M&S Simply Food for something easy for tea before heading home as the afternoon light softens.

- Retirees who prefer walkable, level access to daily amenities
- Anyone who enjoys riverside greens and harbour views without needing a car
- Those who value quiet convenience with community venues within easy reach

### Approximate distances (on foot)

- Saxon Square (Post Office, Iceland; cafés): ~6–10 minutes
- Barrack Road/Bargates bus stops (X1/X2; local routes): ~1–3 minutes
- Waitrose (Fountain Roundabout) / M&S Simply Food (High Street): ~8–12 minutes
- GP surgery (Stour Surgery, Barrack Road): ~1–3 minutes
- Christchurch Quay/Priory Gardens: ~10–15 minutes
- Christchurch railway station (Stour Road): ~10–12 minutes

*Notes: Walking times vary with pace and route; buses offer simple alternatives for longer trips or fully step-free access.*
